We eagerly anticipate your participation and are excited to provide you with a stimulating and enriching professional experience at our conference.

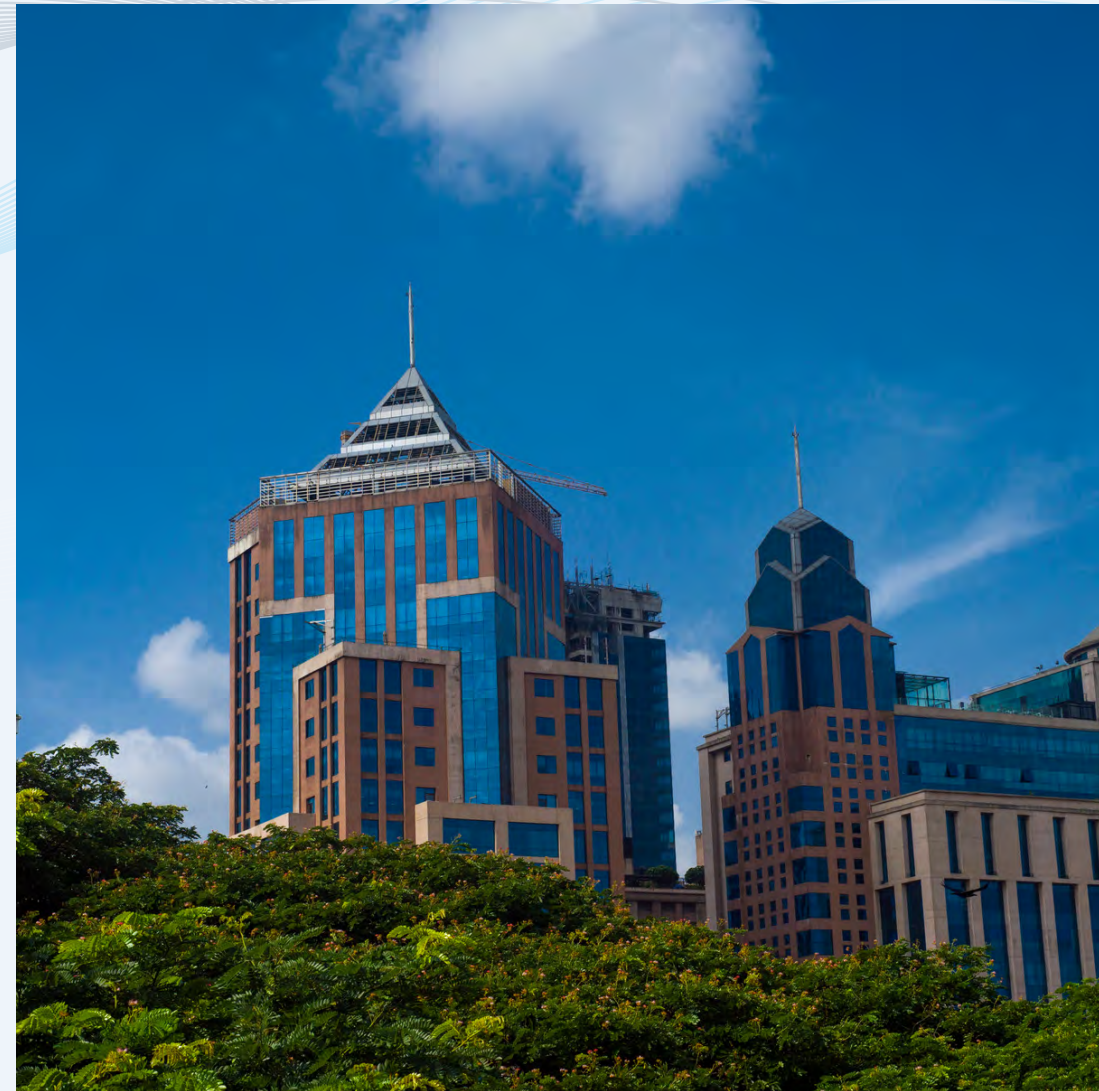

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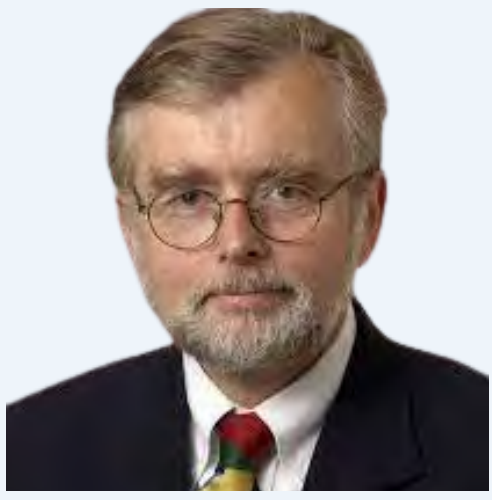

NQOCN organised its 1st International Conference on Healthcare Quality and Patient Safety at Pravara Institute of Medical Sciences, Loni, Maharashtra, on 12 & 13 November 2022.

Highlights

Call for Papers/Posters

Abstract Submission and Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Only registered delegates can submit their papers/posters.
- Scientific paper/poster to be submitted initially in soft copy for evaluation by the expert committee latest by **30th September 2023**. The decision of the expert committee shall be final.
- The expert committee will scrutinize all papers/posters received.
- The corresponding author/s of the posters/papers will be intimated regarding the acceptance of the abstract either as an **AWARD paper, ORAL presentation** or as a **POSTER presentation** as determined by the Scientific Committee.
- There will be prizes in different categories for the best scientific paper and poster. All papers presenters will receive certificates.
- The selected oral papers will be presented at the podium on 5th November 2023. The time and venue will be intimated in advance.
- The oral presentation will be of **5 minutes, followed by 2 minutes for discussion**. Queries from the judges are to be answered only by the presenter and co-author.
- The soft copy of the structured abstract for the paper and poster will be sent to: **papers.nqocnconf@gmail.com**. The maximum word limit for the structured abstract is 400 words.
- Please mention the subject as ORAL PAPER/POSTER FOR NQOCN ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2023 and the category (given below) in the email:

a. Categories for papers

- **Patient Safety (incl. patient-partnered interventions)**
- **Improving Quality of Care**
- **Innovations in healthcare providers/worker's well being**
- **Medical & Nursing Student-Led Improvement Initiatives**

- **Five (5) best papers will be shortlisted by the scientific committee to be considered for AWARD PAPER Session.** The corresponding authors will be intimated well in advance regarding the date & time of the in-person presentation.

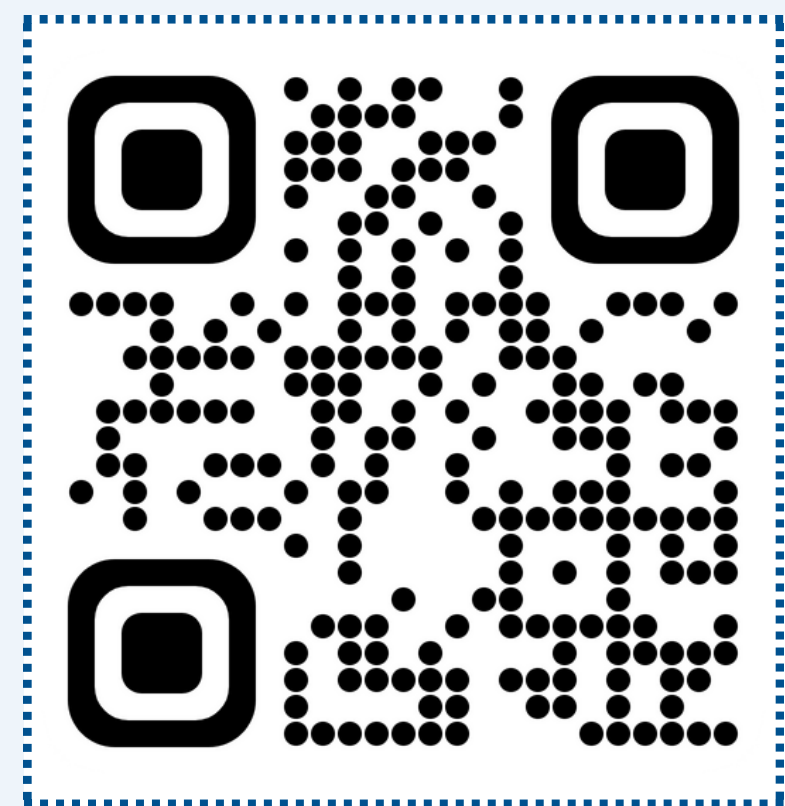

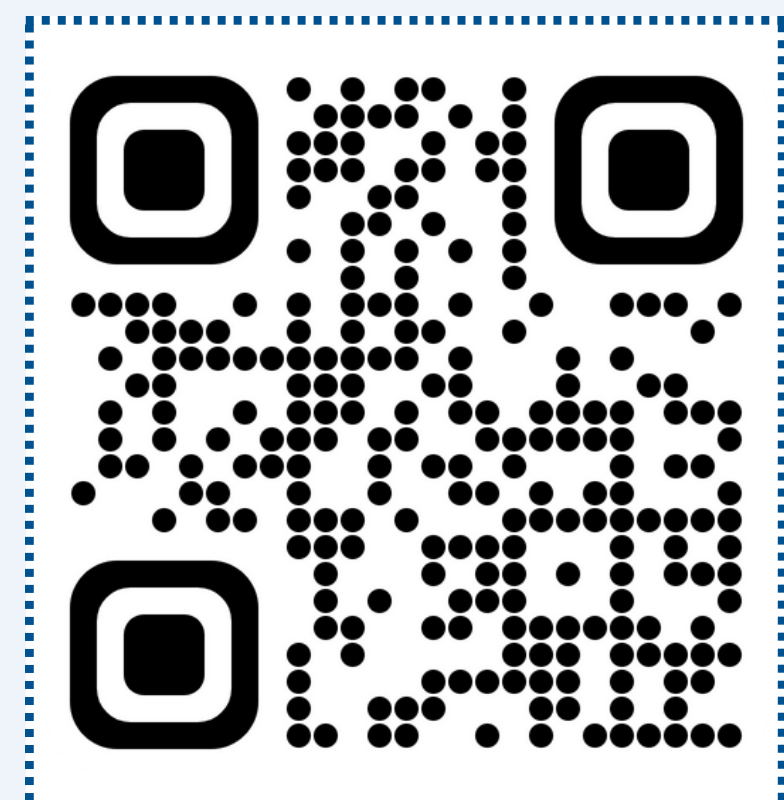
